Classes are designed for people over the age of 16.

There is an expiry date on all class cards. Unused classes on the card cannot be carried over to the next session.

FUNDAMENTALS OF DANCE

Wednesdays or Thursdays 6:30 – 8:00 pm

Fundamentals of Dance builds on principles over the course of a term and progresses to more challenging exercises. For this reason, registration in the full session is required. Single class drop-ins may be permitted in the first 3 weeks of each session. Fundamentals of Dance is offered in three sessions:

Fall 2009: September 15 – December 12

Winter 2010: January 5 – April 1

Spring 2010: April 6 – June 26

TECHNIQUE I

Tuesdays and Thursdays 6:30 – 8:00 pm

TECHNIQUE II

Tuesdays 6:30 – 8:00 pm, Saturdays 1:00 – 2:30 pm

These classes are taught in a drop-in style where dancers pay per class (Single class: \$14). Pre-paid class cards are suggested as a more economical option for regularly attending students. Class cards are valid from the date of purchase until June 26, 2010.

These classes aim to provide an artistic education in contemporary dance forms, including work based on the techniques of Martha Graham and José Limón, as well as contemporary barre work.

Participants learn:

- intricate/advanced floorwork, standing work, and movement phrases
- advanced body mechanics
- increased flexibility and control, co-ordination, and spatial awareness

Since technique classes build on principles learned in previous levels, dancers enrolling in Technique I must have taken Fundamentals of Dance or have some previous dance experience, and dancers enrolling in Technique II must have taken Technique I classes or have previous contemporary experience.
